The Census Data and Geographic Information Services project (formerly known as the Asian and Pacific Islander Center for Census Information and Services) is a U.S. Census Bureau-designated 'census information center' (CIC) that is designed to meet the data needs of community organizations in the Southern California region. CD&GIS aims to raise the capacity of local organizations in providing social and human services through the increased use of data. The project provides published Census materials, technical assistance to groups and individuals, specialized population and demographic reports, and population maps. Cartographer/GIS Specialist Todd Zagurski provides mapping services for Census- and non-Census-based data.
